- Advice and information on reducing the risks and harm associated with any drug
- Help assessing benefits, medical help, housing, legal advice, and ensuring that your rights are respected
- Practical support for keeping on top of the problems that using can create
- Complementary therapies for relaxation

### **People who want to stop using or to change their drug use**

- A range of talking therapies to help you decide what changes you want to make
- Help planning changes and choosing the best option for you
- General support with putting things back together after a period of using
- Prescribed medication to help you stabilize or detox
- People to talk to and offer you support to make the changes you want to make
- Support in finding a job or a college course
- Complementary therapies to help you while changing or stopping use

### **People concerned about someone else's drug use**

- Information and advice about drugs and a confidential listening ear
- Information about other sources of support and self help

### **People who have stopped using**

- Help with relapse prevention and staying clean
- Practical and emotional support with managing day-to-day and with planning where you want to go next
